RE: Airport Identification/Gate Access Card Application

Fellow Members:

Naples Airport Authority security staff has decided that the best way to issue new ID/Gate Access cards to the members of Naples Flying Club, Inc. is to establish a single "Authorized Signer" (that's me) who will inform about the process, distribute applications, and sign on behalf of the Club.

Attached in .pdf format is a pre-signed application package. The process is fairly simple:

- Read the application, then complete and sign pages 5 & 6
- Call Naples Airport Authority Commercial Terminal Security Manager Raul Estrada at 239.280.9795 and make an appointment to go to his office in the Naples Airport commercial terminal to deliver your application and sit for an ID photograph
- Bring to your appointment two acceptable forms of ID (see item 4. on page 4.) one of which must be a picture ID which can consist of your US Passport, a current Florida driver's license, or other picture ID issued by Federal, State or local government agency
- After about 10 days after your appointment expect to receive a call to return to Raul's office to surrender your old ID card and pick up your new ID card.

The new cards must be displayed in plain view on the outside of your clothing at all times while inside the gate. You are responsible for those accompanying you. There is a significant charge for lost or stolen cards. Under no circumstances can you loan or transfer your card to another. When you leave Naples Flying Club, Inc. surrender your card to the Club secretary.

According to the application, the "Authorized Signer" assumes some responsibility and I would appreciate it if you would abide by the rules and not get me in more trouble than I am already.
